Introduction

The CL12611IP340 Transmitter converts 24/32/40/48bits LVCMOS parallel data into 3/4/5/6-channnel sub-LVDS serial data streams. A Phase-locked transmit clock is transmitter in parallel with the data streams. The CL12611IP340 transmitter is programmed for rising edge or falling edge clocks through a dedicated pin. At a transmit clock frequency of 340MHz, 24/32/40/48bits data are transmitted at a rate of 680Mbps per sub-LVDS data channel. The CL12611IP340 Transmitter is an ideal means to solve EMI and cable size problems associated with wide, high speed CMOS interface.
